



NAME A CRUMPIT WOODS STREET

The Crumpit Woods development team needs your help and creativity. There are five streets to be named in the new Crumpit Woods subdivision and we are looking for suggestions from the entire Squamish community.

This is an invitation to get involved and get creative; build a neighbourhood theme or enter just one name. Make sure you take advantage of this unique opportunity to make your mark on Squamish. Plus, if your street name is chosen you will win a \$250 gift card from Rona Squamish!

Contest Guidelines

1. A maximum of 18 characters including spaces and suffixes (i.e. St, Ave, Rd etc.).
 2. The street name must be pleasant sounding, easily recognizable and pronounceable to the average individual.
 3. The following suffixes may be used: Street, Lane, Place, Avenue, Drive, Road, Way, or Court.
 4. Consideration should be given to names of local area or historic significance.
 5. Avoid existing or similar sounding street names within the District of Squamish.
 6. Avoid re-using former street names because of the confusion this may cause.
 7. Avoid names that have silent letters at the beginning (i.e. Knight Street).
 8. The use of names that include apostrophe's, hyphens and prefixes (i.e The) are discouraged.
 9. The following are not permitted:
 - a. Symbols (i.e. !, @, # etc.)
 - b. Offensive, discriminatory or derogatory language
 - c. Product or brand names
 10. Names of living persons should be used only in exceptional circumstances.

- This contest is open to all Squamish residents.
 - Only one entry form per person may be submitted, but you may enter up to five street names per form.
 - All submissions must be accompanied with the entrant's name, address, phone number and email address.
 - All submissions must be submitted via the entry form on www.crumpitwoods.com/contest.
 - The contest period is from Thursday, March 14th, 2013 to Thursday, April 11th, 2013
 - Deadline for submission is: Thursday, April 11th, 2013 at midnight
 - The winning names will be selected by the developer and are then subject to District of Squamish approval.
 - The developer has the right to refuse all names.
 - Commemorative names, if chosen, will have to go to District of Squamish Council for approval.
 - The winners will be announced online and on Mountain FM once they have been approved by the District of Squamish.
